Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival in Kathmandu

Arrive at Tribhuvan International Airport in Kathmandu. Welcome, meet, and assist our Going Nepal representative & transfer to the hotel. Welcome drink followed by tour briefing. Evening welcome dinner at a local restaurant. Stay Overnight in Kathmandu in Chandragiri Hills

Day 2: Full Day Sightseeing in Chandragiri

Wake up early in the morning. After breakfast, visit the Chandragiri Cable Car, which offers a scenic ride up to the top of the hill. From here, you can enjoy stunning views of the Kathmandu Valley and the surrounding mountain ranges. Afternoon exploring the surrounding area. You can visit the Chandragiri Temple, which is located on the hills and offers panoramic views of the surrounding landscape. You can also visit the Kalika Temple, which is located nearby and is an important Hindu shrine. In the evening, you can visit the Bhaleshwor Temple, which is located at the base of the hill and is an important Hindu shrine. You can also visit the local markets and try out some of the local food and drinks. Stay overnight in Chandragiri Hills.

Day 3: Visit Swayambhunath, Kathmandu Durbar Square, and Patan

Wake up early in the morning. After breakfast, visit a Full day Kathmandu city tour to Swayambhunath Kathmandu Durbar Square and Patan Durbar Square. Located at the top of the hill, Swayambhunath which is also known as the monkey temple "Swayambhunath" means "self-created" and refers to the belief that the hill emerged spontaneously from the great lake that once covered Kathmandu Valley. It had become an important center of attraction for both Hindu and Buddhist religions. After finishing a tour of Kathmandu Durbar Square Situated in the heart of old Kathmandu city at Basantapur, Kathmandu Durbar Square never fails to impress first-time visitors with its ensemble of palaces, courtyards, and temples built during the Malla period. The Durbar Square includes the Hanuman Dhoka Royal Palace, the historic seat of royalty; the magnificent Taleju Temple towering more than 40 meters; Kumari Ghar, the residence of the Living Goddess, Kumari; Ashok Vinayak, also called Kathmandu Ganesh, a temple without a filial; and Kal Bhairav, the God of Wrath. The capital takes its name from the giant pagoda of Kasthamandap, which is said to have been built out of a single tree. Since the time of the Malla kings, Durbar Square has been the city's social, religious, and political focal point. After visiting Kathmandu Durbar square, we will move to Patan Durbar Square is a historic palace complex located in the city of Patan, Nepal. It is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and is known for its beautiful architecture and cultural significance. The complex is home to several important temples and palaces, including the Patan Durbar (Palace) itself, which was built in the 17th century and was the seat of the Malla kings of Patan. The palace is now a museum and is open to the public. Other notable buildings in the complex include the Krishna Temple, which was built in the 16th century and is one of the finest examples of Newari architecture in Nepal. The temple is known for its intricate stone carvings and is an important Hindu shrine. Overnight at Hotel.
